

QUARTERLY UPDATE ON TPOS 2020 ACTIVITIES

Steering Committee Meeting and Technical Workshop Recap

The TPOS 2020 Steering Committee were hosted by the Second Institute of Oceanography (SIO) for their sixth meeting from 4-7 November 2019 in Hangzhou, China. A one-day technical workshop preceded the main session. A majority of Steering Committee members attended both sessions, as well as Chinese experts and a variety of TPOS stakeholders.

The technical workshop focused on reinvigorating the development of a "Core TMA Technical Document" and sharing TPOS-relevant Chinese activities. An updated author list from all relevant agencies was identified and it was agreed that this document will be (continued on next page)

OCEAN SCIENCES MEETING

TPOS 2020 was very present at the 2020 Ocean Sciences Meeting in San Diego through a session and community networking event. Shelby Brunner, Meghan Cronin, Janet Sprintall, and Adrienne Sutton chaired "TPOS 2020: Advancing the Needs for Research and Stakeholders," which featured oral and poster sessions. The oral presentations were particularly notable since 5 of the speakers were early career scientists.

On Wednesday evening there was a community networking event intended to bring together various TPOS communities - particularly those involved in NOAA-funded TPOS activities and the international TPOS project. Almost 40 "TPOS-minded" people gathered for casual conversation and food. One notable outcome from this event was that the post-docs involved in a variety of TPOS projects were able to understand the broader community, as well as recognize that they are one cohort.



Highlights from the science talks include that SIO has secured funding for adding additional Argo floats to the Tropical Pacific, including biogeochemical floats and that the Chinese Academy of Sciences is increasing coordination of ocean activities that will ultimately benefit TPOS and other global efforts. Participants were also given a tour of SIO facilities.

The Steering Committee meeting was focused on identifying unfinished business of the current Steering Committee and task teams, the future governance structure of TPOS 2020, and the transition process to the new structure.
